

Importing a Text File into XPAD Ultimate and Creating a New Site (Project folder)




Open XPAD Ultimate and Select New/Open Job



The Next Screen Will Displays Sites.

By selecting in the Black bar at the Top you will see an Option to add a New Site. The Sites work the same as Job Folders where all information pertaining to your project will be stored.

Select New Site.



On the New Site Screen there are several options.

Site Name: Name of your Project.

Annotation: Here you can add Notes about the Project if desired.

Collaborative Survey (XPAD 365): Here you can perform a Collaborative Survey with Field and Office if you XPAD 365 Professional.


Select Accept.

On the New Job Screen, you will see the following options.

Site: This is your Site Name (Folder)

Job Name: Name of your Project you create.

Collaborative job: Here is the second option for Collaborative Survey if you have purchased XPAD 365 Professional.

Reference Job: You can load a reference Job if desired.

Codes Library: Your Feature Code List if you have created one or you can use the Default -US.

GIS Features: Here you load your GIS Attribute Data Table if desired.

Annotations: Note about Project if desired.

Next Check Your Coordinate System


Cartographic System: State Plane Zone your project is located in.

Base Position Adjustment: Defaults according to State Plane


Ground to Grid Scale Factor: Here is where you would manually input your Scale Factor for Ground to Grid.

Select the arrow to the left.




On your computer and with your device connected via USB cable to your Android Device.


Select the Device/Internal Storage/XPAD/Site Name.




You will see a Data Folder, My Site Folder, and any other Site Folders (Named Sites). Select your Site.




Selecting your Site paste the file(s) from your computer into the Import Folder of your Site.

On the Import Data Screen select Import Text File (ASCII)




Select File

Schem: PN-NEZ-C (USA)


Separator: Comma

Point Name: Checked


North Coordinate: Checked

Select Accept in the lower right corner.




You will now see a report of the Imported Points

Imported Points: Number of Points


Discarded Points: 0
